3. If you are applying to a program that is longer than 90 days, after receiving the acceptance letter, please obtain a student visa with the Certificate and your passport in the closest Ecuadorian Consulate in your country of residence.

4. After obtaining a student visa, inform us of your travel plans.

5. Payment must be made in advance of arrival. Please see CEI Refund Policy.

†Insurance policy must be valid for the length of student's stay and sufficient to cover emergency evacuation and repatriation of remains.

‡The Universidad Espíritu Santo reserves the right to place students in the appropriate Spanish level dependent on ability and not student preference.
