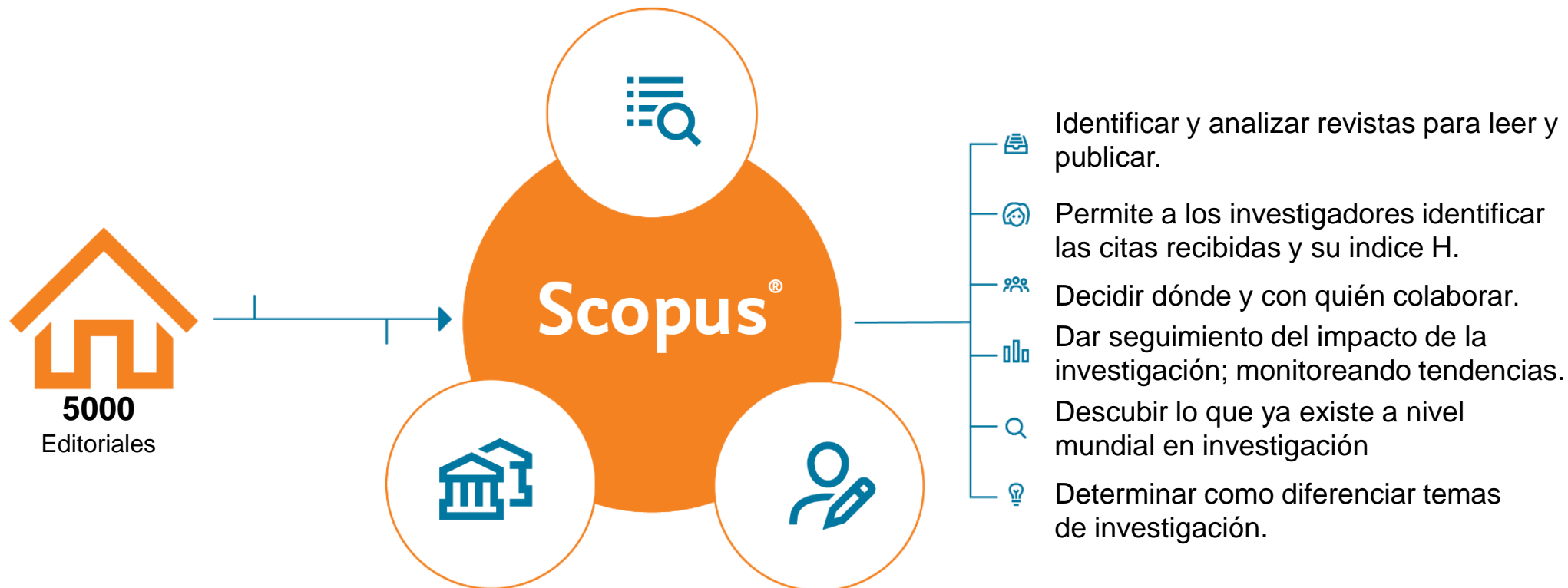
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¿Qué es Scopus?

Scopus es la mayor base de datos de resúmenes y citas de literatura revisada por pares en el mundo, cuenta con herramientas inteligentes que le permiten rastrear, analizar y visualizar la investigación académica. No contiene texto completo ya que, su objetivo es orientar al usuario a encontrar información relevante a partir de un análisis cuantitativo (indicadores bibliométricos)

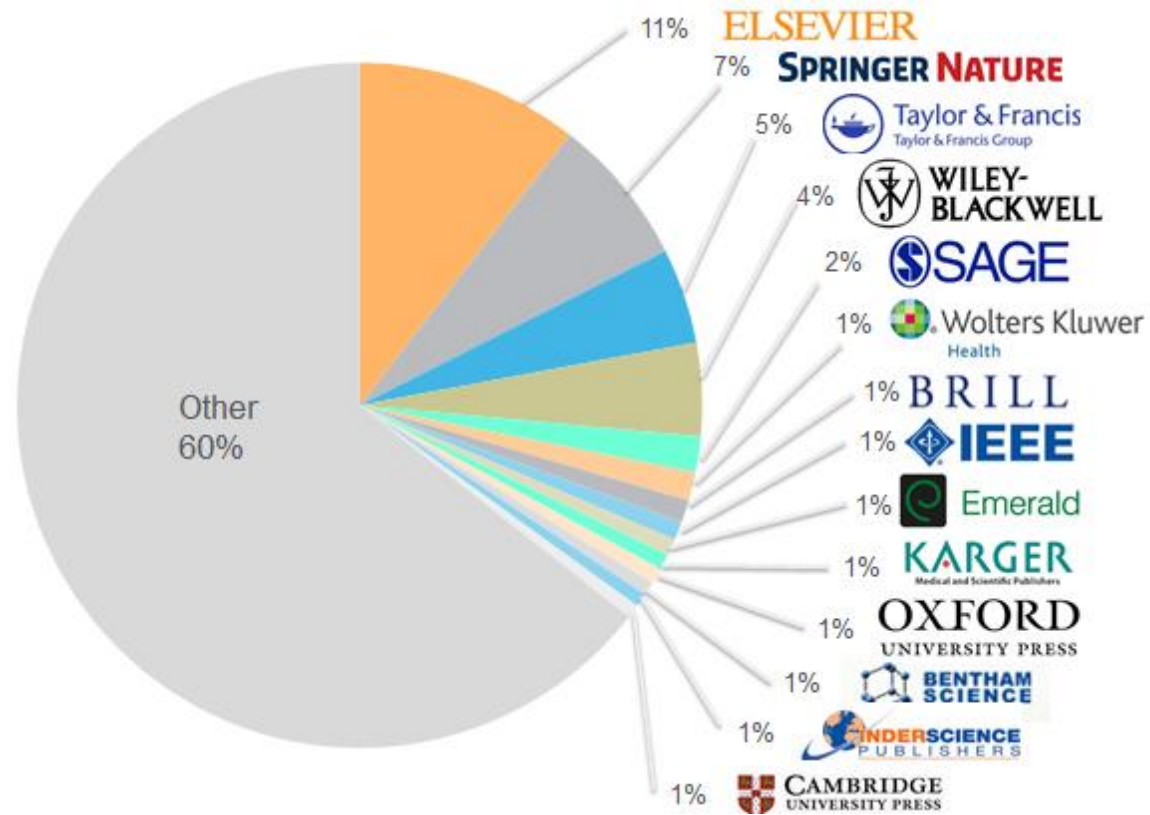
